Pedro Laboy Arruffat, 86, of Ponce, Puerto Rico, went to live with the Lord on May 24, 2019, at current home in Orlando, Florida, surrounded by family and friends. He was born May 22, 1933, in Ponce, Puerto Rico, to the late Pedro Laboy Garcia and Lucia Arruffatt. He served the US Army, in which he participated in the Korean War. He worked as an Engineer drafter at a petroleum refinery, (CORCO of Puerto Rico), and at the Department of Transportation. He was famous for painting banners (cruzacalles), restoring famous murals like Morellos mural in Ponce historic Theatre and using his artistic calligraphy to write names on diplomas.

Pedro Laboy Arruffat was always a soft-spoken man, funny, hard worker, a family man, a great husband, and a wonderful father. He always took out time not only to spend quality time with his sons. He gathered neighborhood children and took them to outings, beach or made activities.

He is survived by his wife Virgen Lydia Perez, sons, Pedro and Alexander Laboy, grandchildren, great grandchildren and great-great grandchildren.
