



Mr. Philip B. Boyle

After a long and loving life, Mr. Philip B. Boyle, 83, of Orlando, passed away peacefully Monday, July 14, 2014, surrounded by family. He is survived by his loving wife of 55 years, Mary Boyle, four children, Kathleen & husband Billy Drury, Philip Boyle, Brendan Boyle & wife Kelly Galea, and Daniel Boyle & wife Eileen, and 11 grandchildren, Zachary, Sarah, Ryan, Dylan, Noah, Connor, Haley, Shannon, Nathan, Garrett and Sean. He is also survived by his brother Patrick Boyle.

Phil was born in Hanover Township, Pennsylvania to John and Irene Boyle, the sixth of seven children. He served in the US Navy on submarines for two years. He spent his retirement volunteering with St. Johns, administering to the sick and serving weekly at The Plantation Oaks nursing home.
