“ It's with a heavy heart I learn, belatedly, of the passing of a good elementary school chum, then high school too. Randy and I went to, as compared to today, a very strict, straitlaced elementary school. Scotch School, founded by Scotch and German immigrants 200 years before, was where we learned the three R's. I first got to really know Randy in Band Class. He played either Clarinet or Sax. But by then, we were both taking Accordion lessons too. In the fourth grade, after hearing Randy play "Lady of Spain" on the Accordion and sounding just like Myron Floren on The Lawrence Show, I quietly switched to the Trumpet. I said to myself, "Holy Cow, this guys Good!" The year was 1958. I remember many happy times in high school, playing music at Randy's home and his mother making the most delicious but unpronounceable German food for lunch. He went down the musical road, playing with many groups including Bob Seger and the Silver Bullet Band. I went into broadcasting. At one of the school Talent Shows, about 9th grade, Randy entered his band. You had to "try out" to make the cut. I was already named Emcee. There was a question the teachers had to resolve. Randy's band had older (18yrs) musician's that weren't enrolled in WBHS. Big Deal! So at the tryouts, he shows up with three pieces, all young guys. Remember, we were "old guys", we were 15. (grin) They audition and get the gig. I mean no other bands were on the ticket. So, the night of the big Talent Show, Randy shows up with his real band. I recall something like six or seven pieces. I take the stage, "And now ladies and gentlemen, please welcome Randy Lobeck and the Sparkle Tones!!!". (I forget what he called the band but back then, everyone ended with 'Tone". The Chrome Tones, etc.) Well. They open up with the loudest, coolest version of Wild Weekend. You know, it had a Sax lead. They brought the house down. The teachers went berserk for a full year, trying to make sure no student would do that again! We Must have order! The students loved it. Randy was on his way. I'll miss my friend.

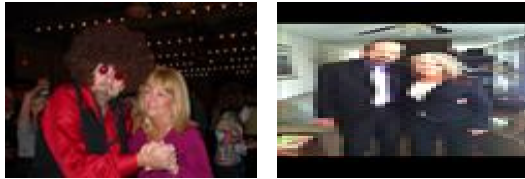

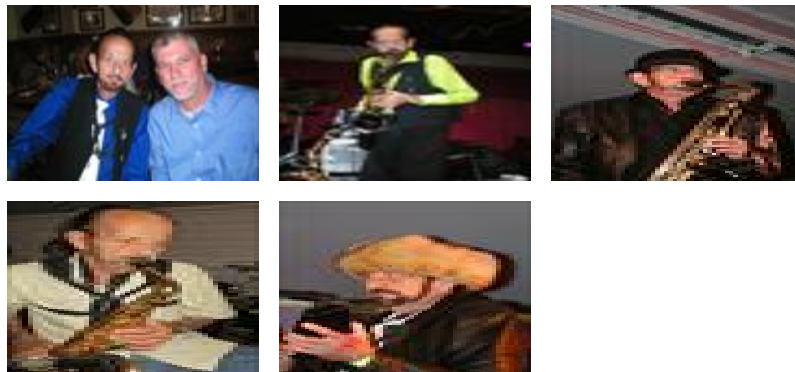
