



## Dr. Robert Corbin Mumby

April 3, 1930 - June 27, 2015

Dr. Robert Corbin Mumby, 85, of Orlando, Florida, passed away on June 27, 2015 at The Commons at Orlando Lutheran Towers. Robert was born on April 3, 1930 in Miami, Florida to Frank Welford Mumby, Jr. and Clara Corbin Mumby. He was a graduate of Sewanee, The University of the South, where he participated in the Air Force ROTC, and from the University of Miami School of Medicine.

Robert served in The United States Air Force from 1954 - 1991 both on active duty as well as in the reserves. He was named Flight Surgeon of the Year in 1965 and received multiple rewards and commendations during his service. He served in Desert Shield/Storm from August 1990 - July 1991, and retired in 1991 with the rank of Colonel.

Robert began his medical career in Orlando in 1966 and founded Orlando Orthopaedic Center in 1972 along with Dr. J. Darrell Shea. He was instrumental in the establishment of the Spinal Injury Unit at Lucerne Hospital.

He is survived by his wife of 55 years, Peggy (Ward) Mumby; daughters Robyn Mumby Zigmond, husband Michael; Jennifer Mumby Bazante, husband Jose Fernando; Rebekah Mumby Petrelli, husband John; son Robert Corbin Mumby, Jr., husband Enrique; grandchildren Ashleah Elisabeth Zigmond, Zachary Michael Zigmond, Maria Alejandra Bazante, Isabella

Bazante, Justin Thomas Petrelli, and Ian Corbin Petrelli; and brother Frank Welford Mumby, III.
