Roman Taras Skrobko, loving husband, brother & friend to so many, died peacefully at home after a 4 year war with colorectal cancer on July 28th, 2023.

Co-founder of Florida's oldest independent Record Store, East West Records (est.1971), Roman loved music, fishing, & his beautiful critters. He always had a way with plants & animals & kids.

Roman was, 1st & foremost, Ukrainian-American. Born in a displaced persons camp to his Ukrainian refugee parents, Oleksa & Halyna, in Berchtesgaden, Germany in 1948. His family were among the last to enter the U.S. via Ellis Island. The family made their way to Los Angeles, CA. In 1970, met his future Ukrainian-American wife, Hanna. They were together till the end.

He is survived by loving wife Hanna & big sister Nina.

He touched so many lives & will be missed by anyone who was fortunate enough to know him.
