Sebastian Kyle Miller, 34, of Orlando, Florida, passed away on March 6, 2026. Born on July 3, 1991, in Merrillville, Indiana, Sebastian brought light and joy to the lives of everyone who knew him.

A graduate of Boone High School Class of 2009, Sebastian went on to earn both his bachelor's and master's degrees from the University of Central Florida (UCF). Sebastian found a special sense of belonging in his work with the educational testing administration team at Cognia. 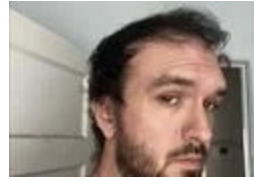
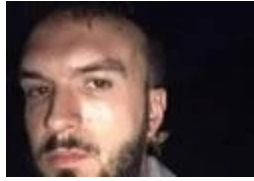

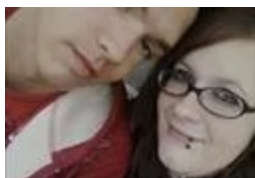
