



## Shioh Ming Pan

August 16, 1931 - October 26, 2025

Shioh Ming Pan, 94, passed away peacefully on October 26, 2025, in Orlando, Florida. Her long and remarkable life was a testament to resilience, compassion, and quiet strength.

Born on August 16, 1931, in Shanghai, China, Shioh Ming grew up in China and Taiwan during a time of great upheaval. She survived the Japanese occupation of China during World War II and overcame Typhoid Fever as a child; early signs of the physical and mental toughness that would define her life.

Shioh Ming pursued a career in nursing in Taiwan, dedicating herself to the care of others with diligence and empathy. After moving to the United States, she continued her professional journey by taking courses to become certified as a nurse here as well. Her commitment to helping others remained steadfast throughout her life.

She married Pei Tai Pan on December 21, 1957, with whom she shared 53 years of partnership

until his passing on May 29, 2010. Together they raised two sons, Davis and Jeffrey. Through her unwavering support and guidance, both sons went on to earn PhDs from MIT; a reflection of the values of perseverance and education she instilled in them.

Despite facing numerous health challenges; including a stroke, two bouts of colon cancer, and an ileostomy; Shioh Ming remained fiercely independent. She continued living in the home she once shared with her husband until her final days. Her ability to maintain autonomy while enduring so much is a powerful part of her legacy.

Shioh Ming found joy in simple pleasures: crocheting gifts for family with care, sewing her own clothes, tending lovingly to her garden, watching classic films that brought back memories of earlier times, watching Chinese YouTube videos, and engaging warmly with neighbors and friends. Those who encountered her were met with kindness, generosity, and a friendly spirit that left lasting impressions.

She is survived by her sons Davis and Jeffrey; grandsons Alex and Connor; sister Mary Claire Chien-Hsu; and brother Kuo-Sheng Hsu. She was preceded in death by her beloved husband Pei Tai Pan and siblings Nei-Chang Hsu, Nelson Hsu, and Jack Hsu.

Shioh Ming Pan's life was one of quiet courage and enduring love. May her

comfort to those who knew her and continue to inspire all who hear her story.
