Steven Douglas Marshall, 60, of Orlando, FL, died of colon cancer on Tuesday, August 14, 2018, following a short illness. Steve was born in Nashville, TN, on October 16, 1957, the son of Robert and Joanne Marshall. He graduated from Oak Ridge High School in 1975. He attended several colleges and universities, eventually receiving two master's degrees.

Steve served in the United States Air Force for thirteen years as a navigator on B52s, obtaining the rank of Captain. Following his time in the Air Force he lived and worked in Texas and Florida. His most recent employment was as a billing associate for Orange County Utilities, where he has many friends and was well known for his potluck dishes, especially his flan.

Steve was known for his photography, his cooking, his love of games like Uno, and his wit and humor. He was a member of Spring of Life United Methodist Church.

Steve was preceded in death by his mother, and his sister, Deborah Lynn Marshall Smith.
