Born on July 27, 1939 in Bac Lieu, Vietnam, our beloved husband, father, and grandfather left a legacy of many talents. He was very patriotic and shared many stories of his experience in the South Vietnamese air force. He loved swimming in the Mekong river and had many fond memories of his country. He never had the opportunity to revisit Vietnam but he died with those memories and held true to the three red stripes and yellow flag that was embedded in his heart forever.

He came to the United States in 1975 and was separated from his wife during the fall of Saigon but they eventually reunited. They built a simple and humble life for 38 years. He started as an auto mechanic for Datsun Nissan and retired as a chef from Mitsukoshi Japanese restaurant in Epcot. He was a tough yet loving man who was very passionate and philosophical about life, morals, and values. He often used an example of three chopsticks held together as a metaphor of an unbreakable bond in a family as opposed to holding one that could easily snap in two. He did not believe in altering the rules of family unity at any cost. His greatest joy came when his children and grandchildren were born.

He will always be remembered for his many talents such as fishing and his culinary skills in making egg rolls, Pho, and barbecue ribs. He was a great auto mechanic and an inventor that could create something new from

something broken. Gardening was his passion and he nurtured and grew exotic fruit trees. Everyone loved his mangos and longans.

We will miss his big bright smile, humor, hilarious sarcasm, and our family dinners with him sitting at the head of the table. He left a wife, 3 children, and 6 grandchildren. We honor the 73 years he lived and look forward to reuniting with him someday.
