It is with heavy and broken hearts that the family of Travis Bell announces his passing far too soon on October 15th, 2015. Travis is survived by his parents Wilson and Nancy Bell, his sister Lisa Nelson and his niece Sarah Nelson.

Travis was born in Gainesville, Florida on February 4th, 1970. He graduated from Florida State University with a degree in Communications and later went on to earn an Associate in Film Production Technology at Valencia College.

Travis loved all things film. He moved to Orlando and earned an Associate degree in Film Production Technology from Valencia College and soon after was employed by Valencia to join the Film Production Technology program where he would go on to share his knowledge and passion for film with incoming students. His most recent accomplishment was his completion of the program for Holocaust Institute for Educators which included travel to Poland where he was deeply affected by his visit to the concentration camps at Auschwitz-Birkenau.

A Memorial service for Travis will be held on Sunday, October 25th at 3:00 pm at the First United Church of Christ Orlando, 4605 Curry Ford Road in Orlando.

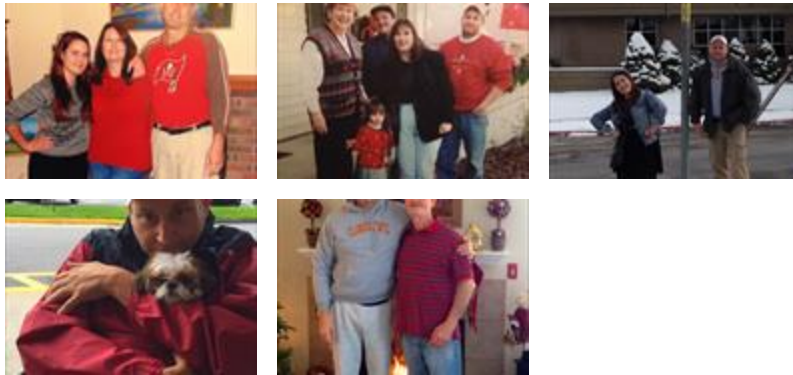
