Ward Dorcas Morrow, was born November 16, 1936 in Rock Hill, South Carolina. The son of the late Thomas and Janie Morrow, he departed to his heavenly home surrounded by family on April 9, 2020 in Orlando, Florida.

Ward was educated in Rock Hill South Carolina. He served in the United States Air Force until 1964 and began his employment with the United States Department of State as a Foreign Affairs Officer. During his tenure with the state department he traveled to over 55 countries until his retirement in 1986. After retiring, Ward returned to serve in interim ambassador positions for the Department of State, Bureau of Consular Affairs issuing U.S. Visas until his second retirement.

Ward loved tennis and political affairs.

Ward will be sadly missed and is survived by his wife, Carmen Morrow, two children Derrick Morrow of Arlington, Virginia and Michele Wiggins of Orlando, Florida, 4 grandchildren, Kierra, Sydney, Briana, Devin; 3 great grandchildren; his 2 sisters, Louise Biggers of Berwyn, Pennsylvania and Cynthia Brown of Exton, Pennsylvania.

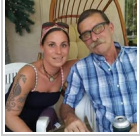

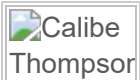
