William "Randy" Johnson was born November 14, 1958 in Smithfield, North Carolina and moved to Orlando, Florida eight weeks later, with his parents and sister. He attended Conway Elementary, Conway Junior High, Boone High School, and Valencia Community College.

Randy was a great athlete. He played football, basketball, and baseball, at Conway Junior High and Boone High School. He also earned the presidential physical fitness award.

His first love was baseball. He learned the basics at Conway Little League, and he was the pitcher.

He pitched for Conway Junior High, Boone High School, and he went on to pitch for Valencia Community College.

Randy started a lawn maintenance company while in high school, and did very well. Some of his clients have been with him over 30 years.

During his youth he was a member of Delaney Street Baptist Church, where he accepted Jesus as his savior. He later attended First Baptist Church of Orlando.

Randy was 6'4" and one neighbor described Randy as a "Gentle Giant". He said: "He never heard a negative word come out of Randy's mouth, and was faithful to all our neighbors."

Randy gave so much and did not ask for anything in return.
