Xiomara Cuéllar was born February 8, 1929 in Barrio Azul, La Habana, Cuba. She is survived by her son Rudi Cuéllar (Lisa); daughter Christina Pinto; granddaughter Chelsea Taborda (Cesar); and nephew and Godson Octavio Armenteros (Thuy). She was preceded in death by her parents, husband Robert and brothers Arturo and Jesus.

As a young woman, Xiomara's passion for education led her to attend college at "Escuela Normal de Maestros de La Habana", from which she graduated in 1950. After graduation, she taught first grade at "Universidad Infantil La Habana". Xiomara met Robert in 1954 a moment that she described as love at first sight. The couple was married on July 6, 1956. Together they owned a locksmith business, "La Casa de las Llaves."

Xiomara and Robert arrived in the United States on January 20, 1966, fleeing Fidel Castro's regime in Cuba and seeking a better life for their young family. She was very grateful to this country and loved the American flag. They lived in New York and New Jersey before coming to Orlando in 1971. The couple re-established the family business, opening the doors to Cuellar's Safe and Lock Co. in downtown Orlando in 1972.

Xiomara was a loving mother, grandmother and friend to many. She was a caring, sweet person who had a heart of gold. She was well-loved and will be

deeply missed.
